- Safety First
- Performances that stop the flow of the parade are not allowed. Performances are allowed if they allow the group to continue to move forward while performing.
- Candy or advertisement may not be thrown from the floats for safety reasons, but may be passed out by parade participants walking along with the float and distributed along curb edge.
- Participants riding on floats for safety reasons must remain on the float until the parade ends.
- A \$25.00 Entry Fee is required for all Political and Commercial Floats. <u>No</u> application fee is required for Non-profits and Schools.
- Parade applications must be in by Monday, December 4, 2017 in order to make the parade line-up by number. Any application received after December 4th will be inserted to the end of the parade line-up in the order it is received. Applications can be mailed to 305 E.
