PARADE RULES

- **SAFETY FIRST.** Float participants should limit numbers so that they may socially distance themselves on the float. Marching and other formations should maintain social distancing on the parade route.
- Performances that stop the flow of the parade are not allowed. Performances must allow the group to continue to move forward while performing.
- Any participants throwing candy, prizes or advertisements from floats must be wearing gloves to do so.
- Participants riding on floats must remain on the float until the parade ends.
- **No additional Santa Claus will be allowed. THE ONLY SANTA ALLOWED IN THE PARADE WILL BE ON THE PORT ISABEL FIRE TRUCK.**
- **NO APPLICATION FEE.**
- To make the parade line-up by number, parade applications must be in by Friday, December 2, 2022 by 12 noon.
